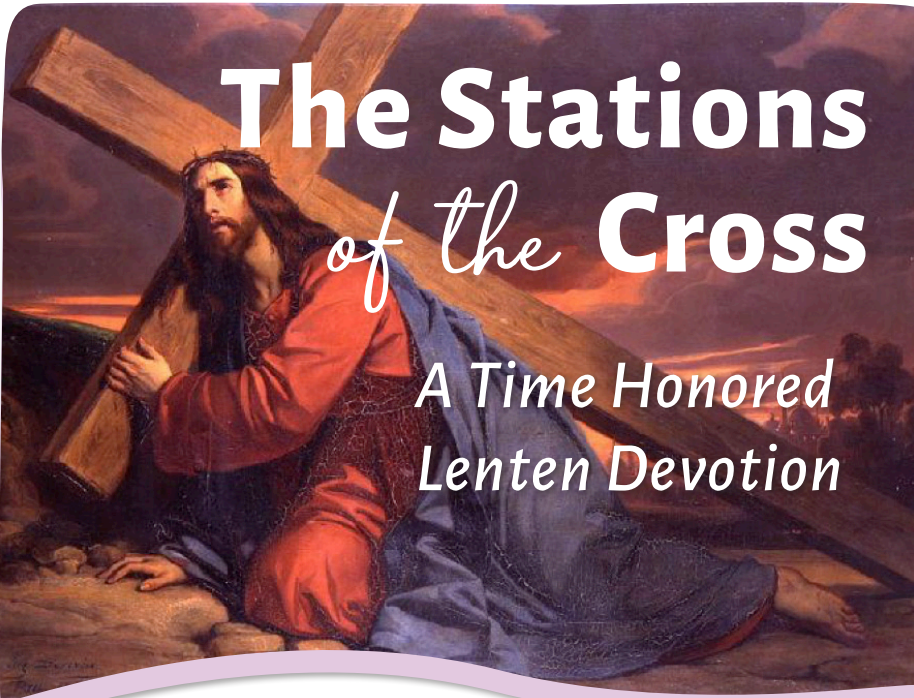

Lenten Devotion*

My Dear Parishioners and Supporters of Saints Peter & Paul Parish,

PEACE IN THE LORD JESUS CHRIST.

As you know, Lent begins this year on March 5nd with Ash Wednesday. The Ash Wednesday schedule, within which Ashes will be imposed, is as follows: **Liturgy of the Word/Prayer Services (not Mass) at 8:30 am, 3pm, 5pm, & 7pm and Mass at 12:10pm.**

As we embark on our annual Lenten Journey, **the Stations of the Cross will be prayed immediately following the 12:10pm Mass on each of the Fridays of Lent, beginning with Friday, March 7, and continuing on Fridays March 14, 21, 28, and April 4 and 11. On the final Friday of Holy Week, Good Friday, April 18, the Stations of the Cross will be prayed solemnly with musical accompaniment that evening at 7pm.** Please plan to join in these opportunities to continue this sacred and time-honored devotion to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The Vatican's Congregation for Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments, in the Document *Paschalis Solemnitatis*, reminds us that: *"The faithful are to be encouraged to participate in an ever more intense and fruitful way in the Lenten liturgy and in penitential celebrations... Devotional exercises which harmonize with the Lenten season are to be encouraged; for example, the Stations of the Cross..."*

Thank you for your continued support, generosity, and prayers for the Parish. Know that you and your Families are remembered in my daily Masses and prayers.

2025 LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the “paschal fast” to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

- *On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity.*
- *Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.*
- *On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.*

2. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence “substantially”, or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

4. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9 to The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2025.

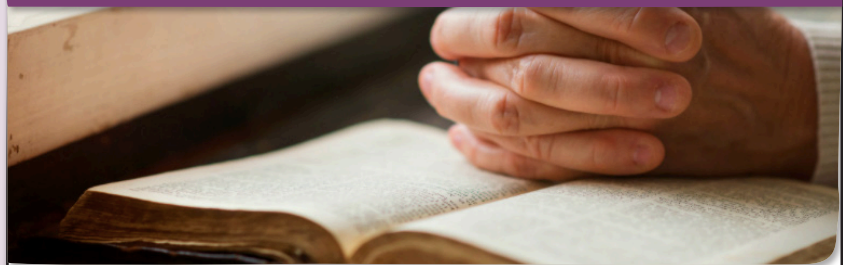
*Canon 920, §1. *All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.*
