It reminds us that even death cannot sever God's eternal love. As followers of Christ, we are called to embody and share this mercy, being signs of hope and healing.

Our Paschal Candle

Remembering Patrick J. Fitzgerald

The Paschal Candle, rightly so, is so prominent a part of the Easter Vigil and Easter Celebrations. It is also an irreplaceable part of the everyday Life of our Catholic Christian Faith, and of each of our Lives. The Candle represents Jesus Christ, the Light of the World. He is present among us in that Holy Candlelight every day, and is a required Presence at every Baptism - the 'arrival'/Initiation of new lives, new members of the Church - and at every Funeral - the 'commendation' of each life back to the Lord.

Each year, that Light of the World is renewed, as a reminder to us of all that Christ means for us and His World. This year, we have been so wonderfully blessed by the donation of the Paschal Candle in Memory of our cherished Patrick Fitzgerald, by his wife, Lynn. Thank you Lynn, not only for this latest generosity to the Parish, but for the example of a Life lived among us in devoted Love not only to Patrick, but to our Lord God, Jesus Christ. PALM SUNDAY

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus's entry into Jerusalem. It serves as a reminder of Jesus's selflessness and his willingness to lay down his life for humanity, and a time to reflect on our own lives and how we can show that same love to others.



The blessing and distribution of palm branches are a visual representation of the crowds who greeted Jesus with palm branches and spread their cloaks on the road. The palms serve as a symbol of welcome, victory, and Jesus' kingship.

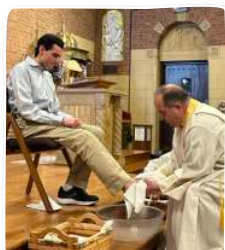


HOLY THURSDAY

In Christian tradition, the foot-washing ceremony takes place on the Thursday before Easter to commemorate Jesus Christ's washing the feet of his 12 disciples at the Last Supper. The ceremony is meant to highlight Jesus' humility and love for all. The early Christian church introduced the custom to imitate Jesus' selfless love.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

This adoration is a sign of devotion to and worship of Jesus Christ, who is present in body, blood, soul, and divinity, under the appearance of the consecrated host.



GOOD FRIDAY

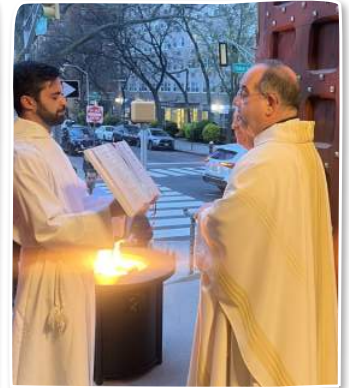
Christians venerate the cross on Good Friday to commemorate the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and his suffering, as well as the salvation he has wrought for believers. The tradition dates back to the 4th century, when Christians in Jerusalem would kneel, bow, and kiss a relic of the true cross in remembrance of the Passion of Christ.
