**Did you know that in the Catholic Church, each of the 12 months of the year has a devotional theme?** For Catholics, February is the month devoted to The Holy Family, and it is an ideal time to strengthen our own family and its connection to Jesus’s family. Continuing our monthly series on ways to showcase each month’s Catholic theme in your life, here are 12 ways you can align your family to the Holy Family this February:

1. **Pray the Family Rosary together.** When you do, add a special prayer to the Holy Family.
2. **Strengthen and/or affirm your family's devotion to the Eucharist** as the nourishment of family life. Purpose to keep the Sabbath holy together, and not let worldly distractions or secular obligations get in the way. Remind everyone of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as you drive to church together. Pope John Paul II wrote, “In the eucharistic gift of charity the Christian family finds the foundation and soul of its communion and its mission”.
3. **Place an icon or image of the Holy Family on your table.** Put a treasured picture of your own family beside it, as a way of seeking blessing and intercession for your family from the Holy Family.
4. **Strengthen your family bonds through shared joy.** During the month of February, plan something fun you can all do together! Maybe it’s a family outing to the aquarium, a sporting event, or a movie. Perhaps it’s baking a special dessert together and sharing the sweetness.
5. **Create a “Family Feast Day.”** You can base it on a devotion to a saint, or the patron saint of your wedding day and/or the day you moved into or blessed your new home. If you haven’t yet had your house blessed or consecrated, make plans to do so! After all, your home is the domestic church for your family, and a beating heart of sorrows and joys where you all dwell and grow. What better month could there be to bless it?
6. **Share stories of beloved family members.** Pay special attention to those who have passed. Tell family anecdotes and pass down the oral tradition. Make sure to talk about those who have lived their faith through difficulties in an exemplary manner! This gives such roots and foundational meaning to our lives and identities as children of God.
7. **Name your home, together with your family,** It can be named after a saint, or take its inspiration from a place in the Bible; it can have something to do with the name of the street you live on, an attribute you strive for, or your last name. But naming your home something gives an epic quality to your life that creates a sense of bonding among family members that cannot be taken for granted.
8. **Bless each other at bedtime** and mention each family member’s name in prayer before falling asleep. Think of that classic television series, The Waltons, which closed each episode with that beautiful ritual!

**As we end each day, let us recall these words of Pope St. John Paul II:  
 “The family, more than any other human reality, is the place in which the person is loved for himself and in which he learns to live the sincere gift of self.”  
 God bless your family.**

# Celebrating World Marriage Day!

February 9 is World Marriage Day! On this World Marriage Day, we thank our heavenly Father for the gift and blessing of marriage and the family.

## About Saint Valentine

St. Valentine's Day is perhaps one of the most celebrated saint days in America; however, the religious understanding of the day has been lost amid the flurry of chocolates, hearts, and jewelry. In taking a look at who St. Valentine was, as well as the reason he has been honored as a saint since the 3rd century, the true meaning of St. Valentine's Day can be uncovered and observed with reverence.

Much of the details of St. Valentine's life have been lost to time. What remains, though, is the story of a man whose love for Christ directed his life, and ultimately led him to a martyr's death. St. Valentine was a Roman priest who ministered to the Christians persecuted under the reign of Claudius II. Because St. Valentine disagreed with the war Rome was engaged in, he took to marrying engaged Christian couples, which meant the men were spared being enlisted in the Roman army, which only took single men. St. Valentine's devotion to the Gospel of Jesus Christ drove him to aid the persecuted Christians in any way he could.

Due to the fact that St. Valentine was a priest, and particularly because he helped the Christians who were oppressed under the rule of Claudius II, he was arrested by the Roman officials. At first, Claudius II took a liking to St. Valentine due to his gentle nature; however, when St. Valentine attempted to convert Claudius II to Christianity, he was ordered to be put to death. While in jail awaiting his martyrdom, St. Valentine restored the sight of the jailer's blind daughter. On the night before he was to be put to death, he wrote a farewell letter to the girl, signing it "From Your Valentine."

St. Valentine was beaten with clubs, then stoned, and when these methods failed to kill him, he was beheaded. The date of his death was February 14, 269 or 270. He was buried along the Flaminian Way. Most of his relics currently reside at the Whitefriar Church in Dublin, Ireland. In 496 Pope Gelasius declared that February 14 would be St. Valentine's feast day, in honor of his martyrdom. In recent years, archaeologists have uncovered a Roman catacomb and ancient church bearing the name of St. Valentine

## Convalidation

Convalidation of a Marriage in the Catholic Church is a process for those who are currently married outside of the Catholic Church (civilly, in another faith tradition, etc.), who for no reason could not have been married in the Sacrament of the Catholic Church to begin with. These are couples who otherwise fulfill all the requirements of Catholic Marriage, and have no 'impediments' (e.g., previous marriages requiring Annulments, etc.) to being Married in the Catholic Church. 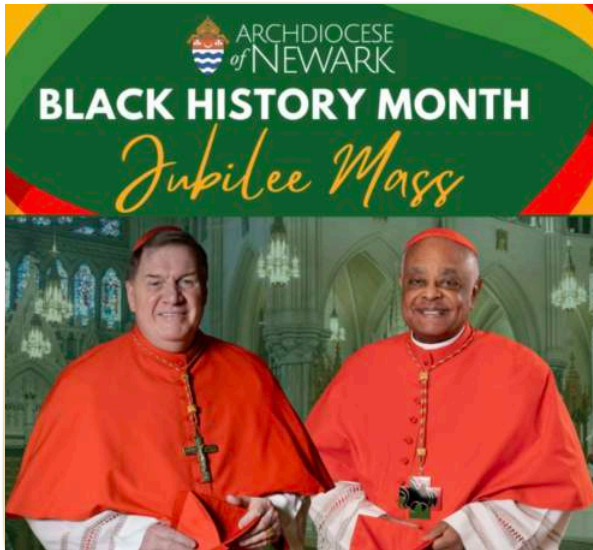
